THREE-MASTED SCHOONER

The S/S Christiania is the latest addition to the Norwegian fleet of sailing vessels. The largest wooden sailing vessel in the country, she is moored in front of the City Hall. Christiania was built in Finland in 1948 and is one of two Norwegian three-masted schooners. Her 550 square meters of canvass make her a good sailer and her lines an attraction to the city.

The passengers saloon is open and bright and has ample room for more than 90 guests. Here one can see the vessel's solid dimensions, with a width of 7 1/2 meters and a superior carpenter craftsmanship wich you seldom see today. It is a pleasure to welcome you aboard the largest and most beautiful vessel afloat on the fjord!
