Fridtjof Nansens ship used for his expedition to the North Pole and by Roald Amundsen to the South Pole. «Gjøa» used for the first expedition through the North West passage.

## HISTORY

### Museum Ferry

In 1898 we established the ferry route between the city and the museum peninsula Bygdøy. After 60 years in business the old boats were scrapped and today's yellow boats were delivered, in the 1950s.



### Fjord sightseeing

In 1946 we started the Fjord Sightseeing, and 7 specially designed boats were delivered during the 1950s. The boats are still sailing today, on Bygdøy and on sightseeing supplied by our larger sail ships.



### Evening schooner cruises

Since 1985 tourists and locals have joined together on our wooden sail ships in the summer evenings. A large traditional Norwegian shrimp buffet is included in the price. Welcome!
